Brief CV of Professor Constantin Petridi

Professor C. Petridi was born in 1923, in Athens, Greece.

His father was Milton C. Petridi, heir to an internationally known tobacco company, founded in Constantinople (now Istanbul) in 1848.



His mother was Nina C. Petridi, born Fauqier, stemming from British colony, Corfu, Greece.

In 1952 C. Petridi married Lisa Skouze, daughter of Dimitri Skouzes and Athina Skouze. He has one son, Milton C. Petridi.

From 1955 to 1972 he was consul for Sweden at Kavala, Greece, location of his family's tobacco business.

Professor Petridi is fluent in English, French, German and Swedish.
