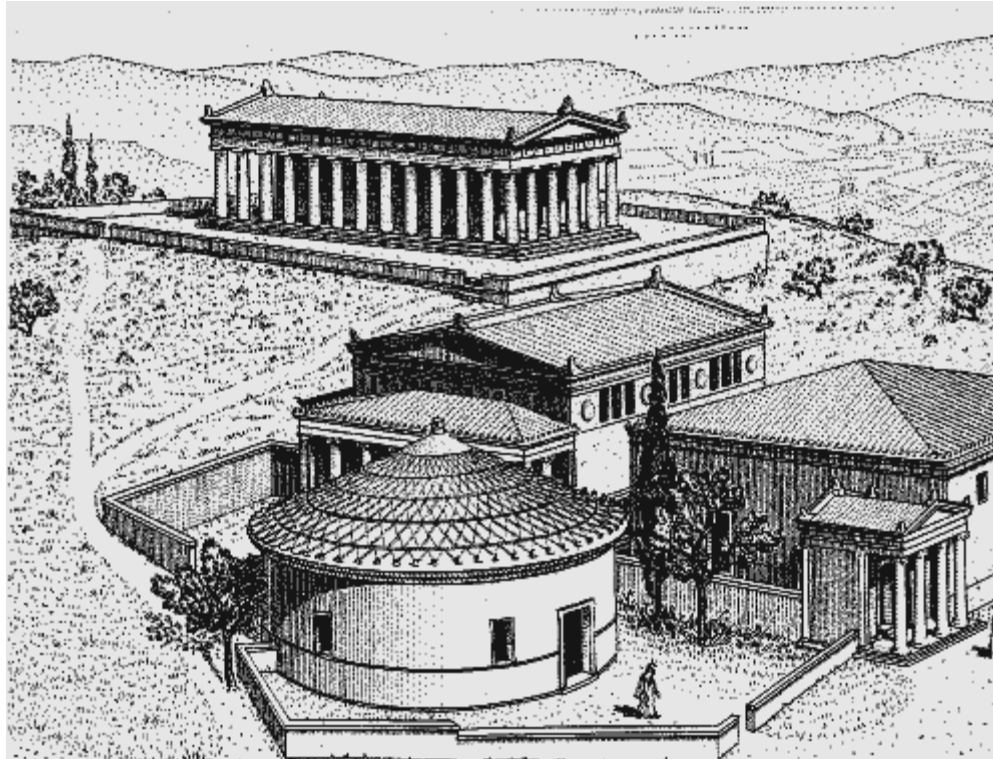

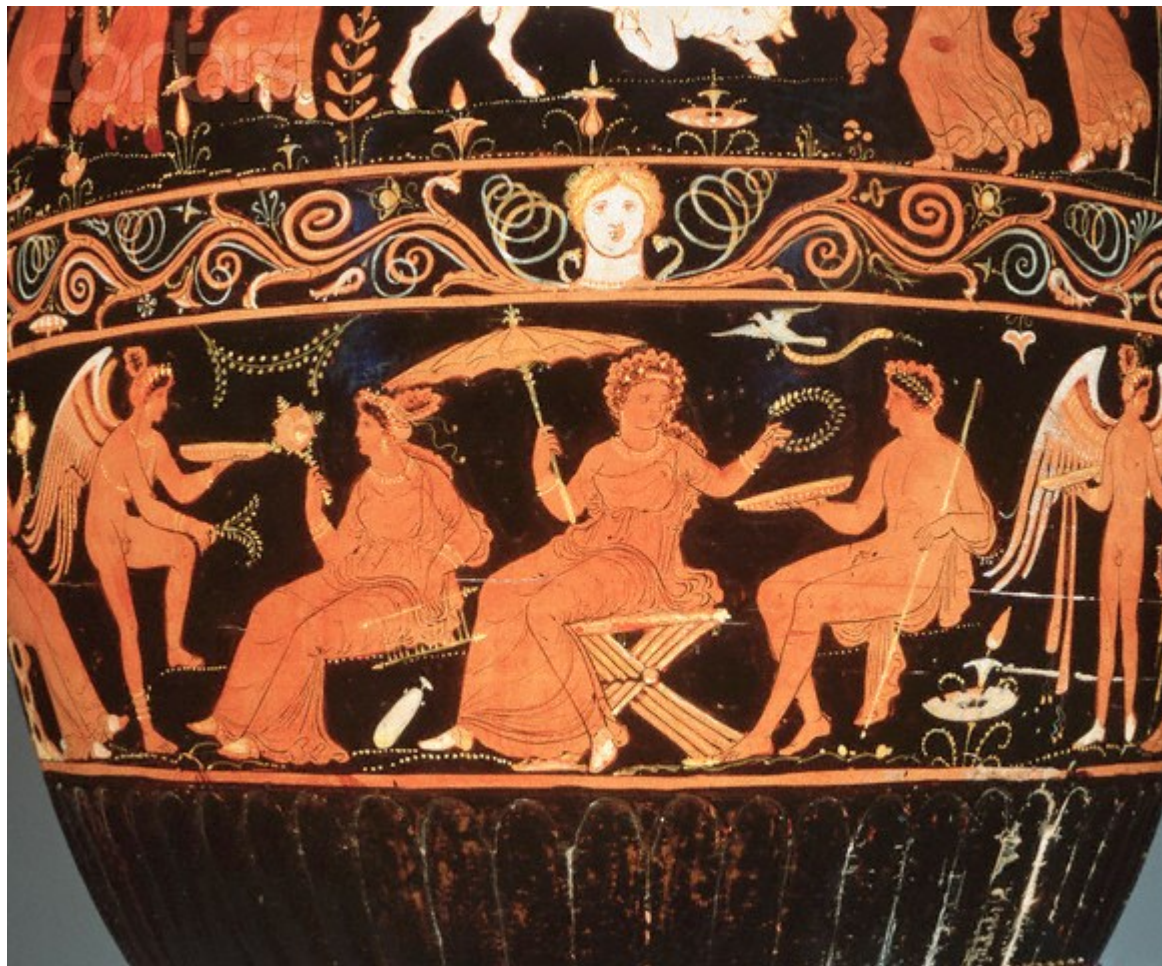
THOLIA AND “SKIADIA”

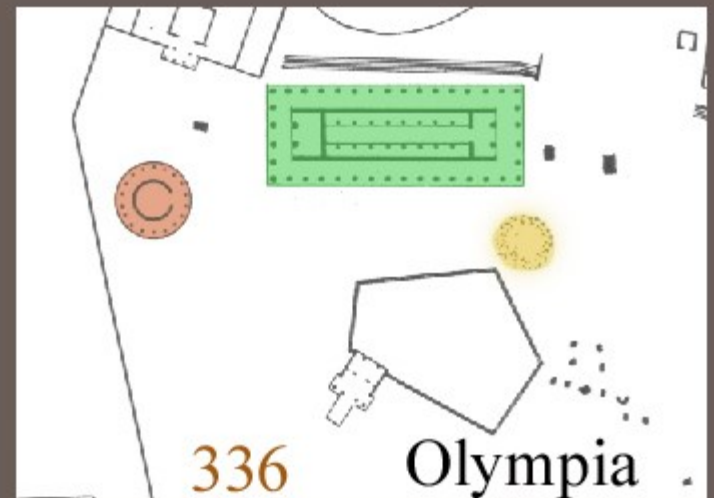
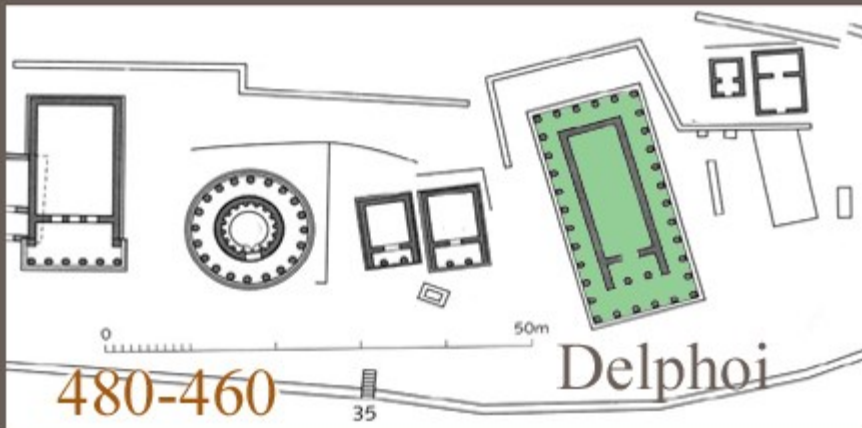
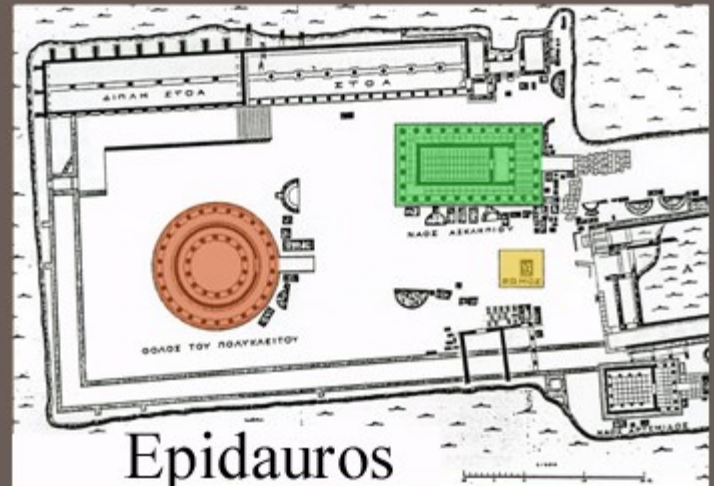
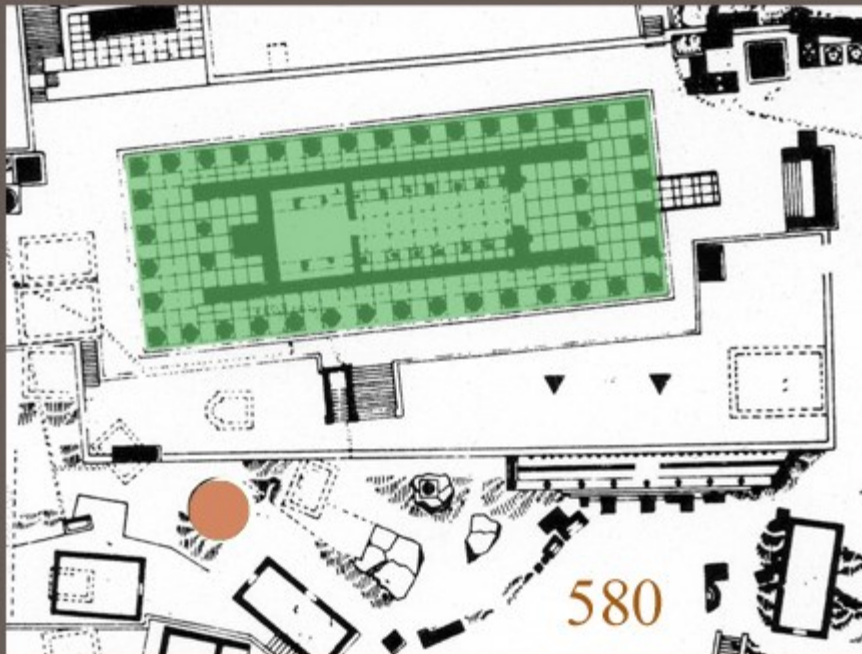
- Το όνομα Σκιάς αποδίδεται στη Θόλο από μια σειρά λεξικογράφων (Αμμώνιος, στο λεξικό του Αρποκρατίωνα, βλ. λ. «Θόλος», Φώτιος και Σούδα, βλ. λ. «Σκιάς», Ησύχιος, βλ. λ. «Σκιάς», EtymologicumMagnum, βλ. λ. «Σκιάς») και από επιγραφές. Οφείλεται στο γεγονός ότι το κτήριο έμοιαζε με σκιάδιον, δηλαδή με ομπρέλα ή ψάθινο καπέλο για τον ήλιο. Από τις φιλολογικές μαρτυρίες (σχολιαστής στον Αριστοφάνη, Ειρήνη, στ. 1183) αναφέρεται ότι η Θόλος ονομαζόταν επίσης Πρυτανικόν







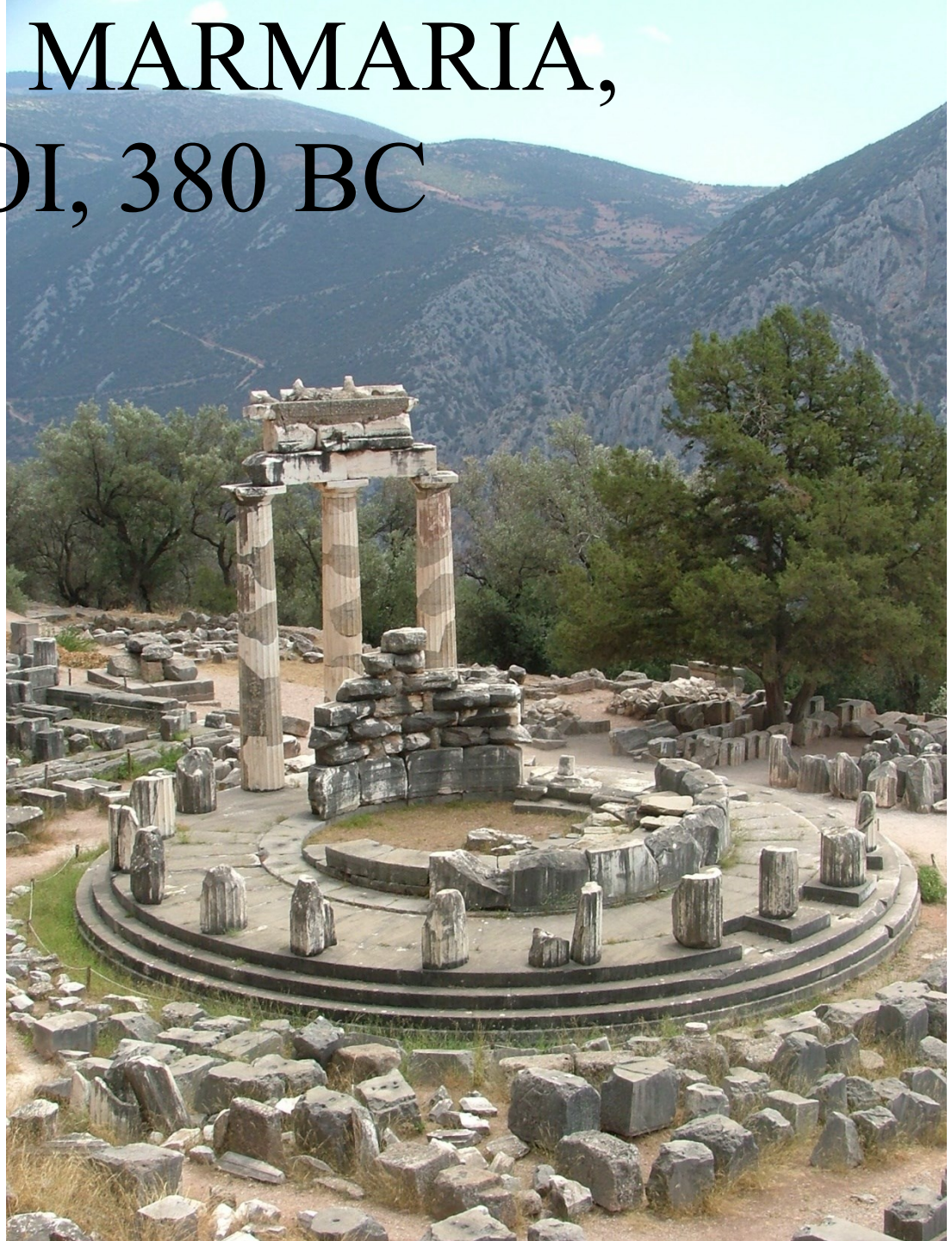




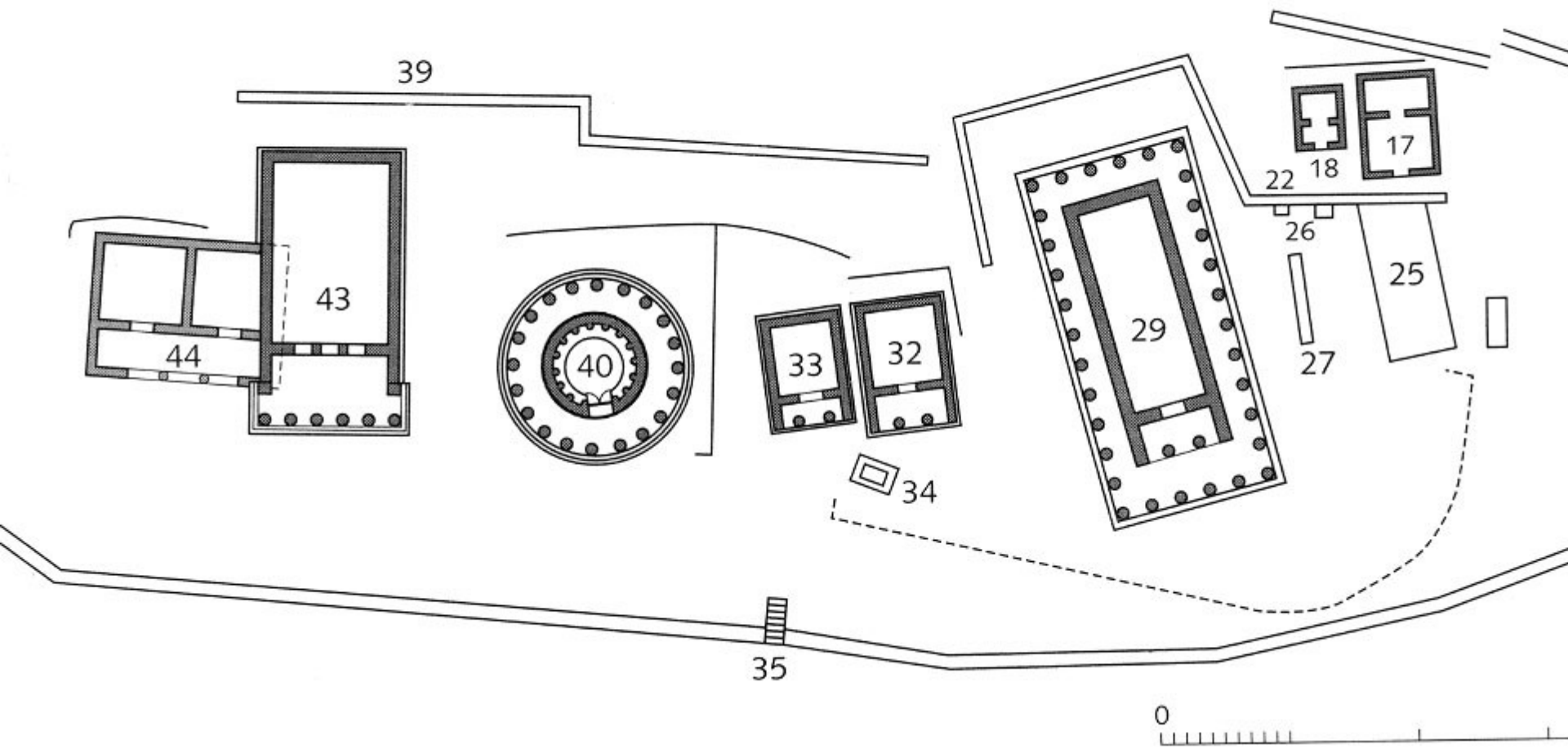
THOLOS OF SICYONIANS AT DELPHOI , 580 BC



THOLOS AT MARMARIA, DELPHOI, 380 BC









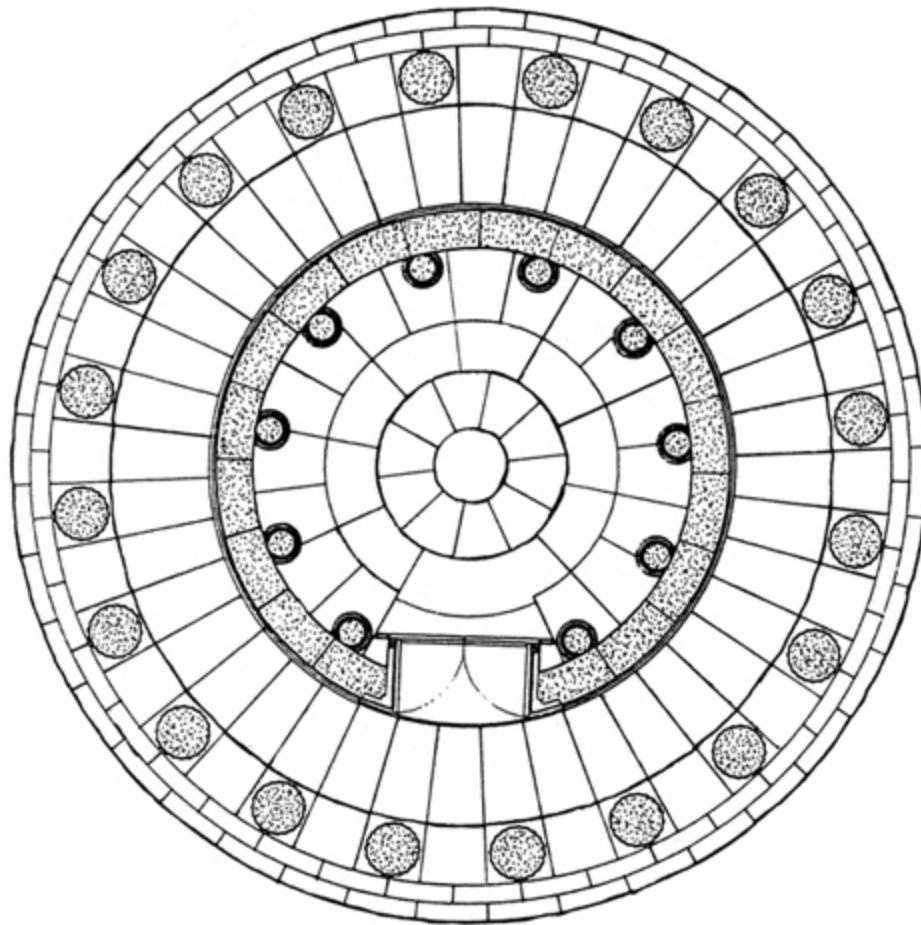

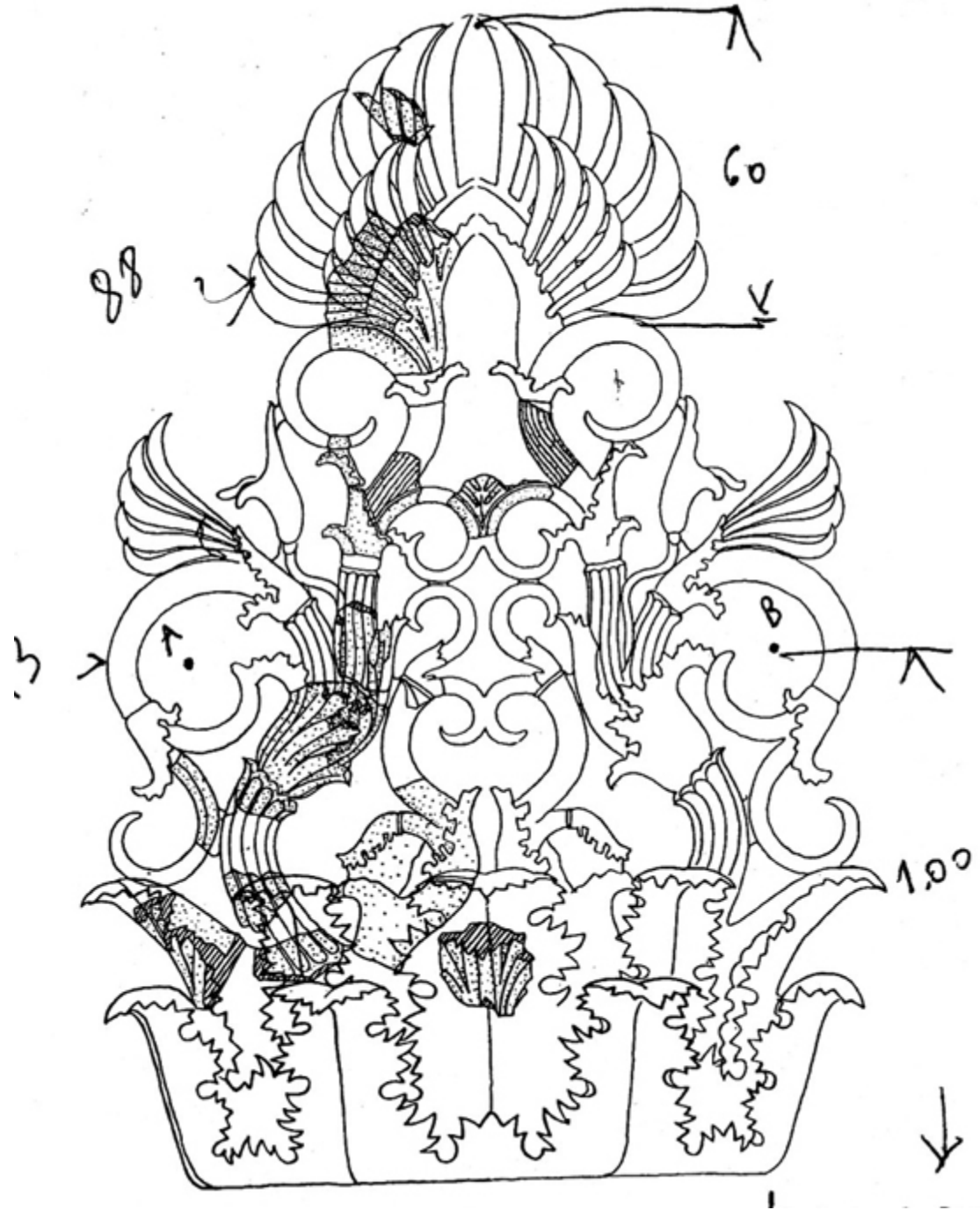
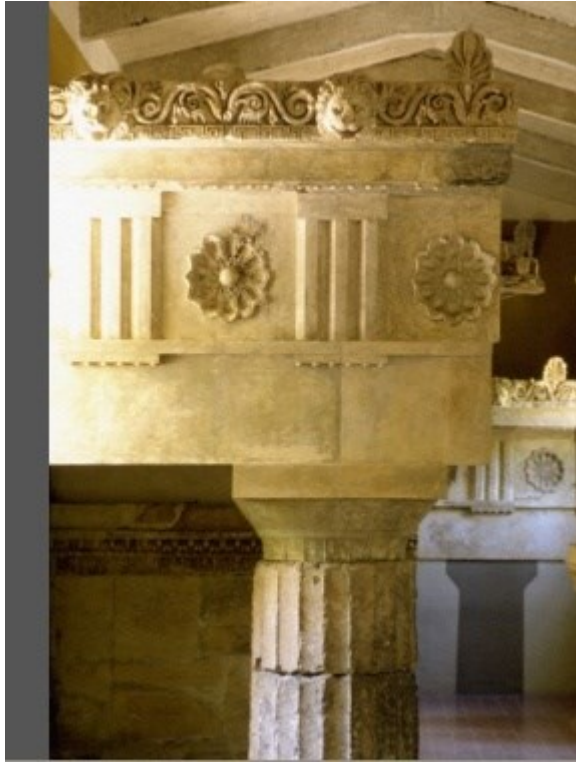




Epidauros, restored Tholos
in Sanctuary of Asklepios, mid-IV BC

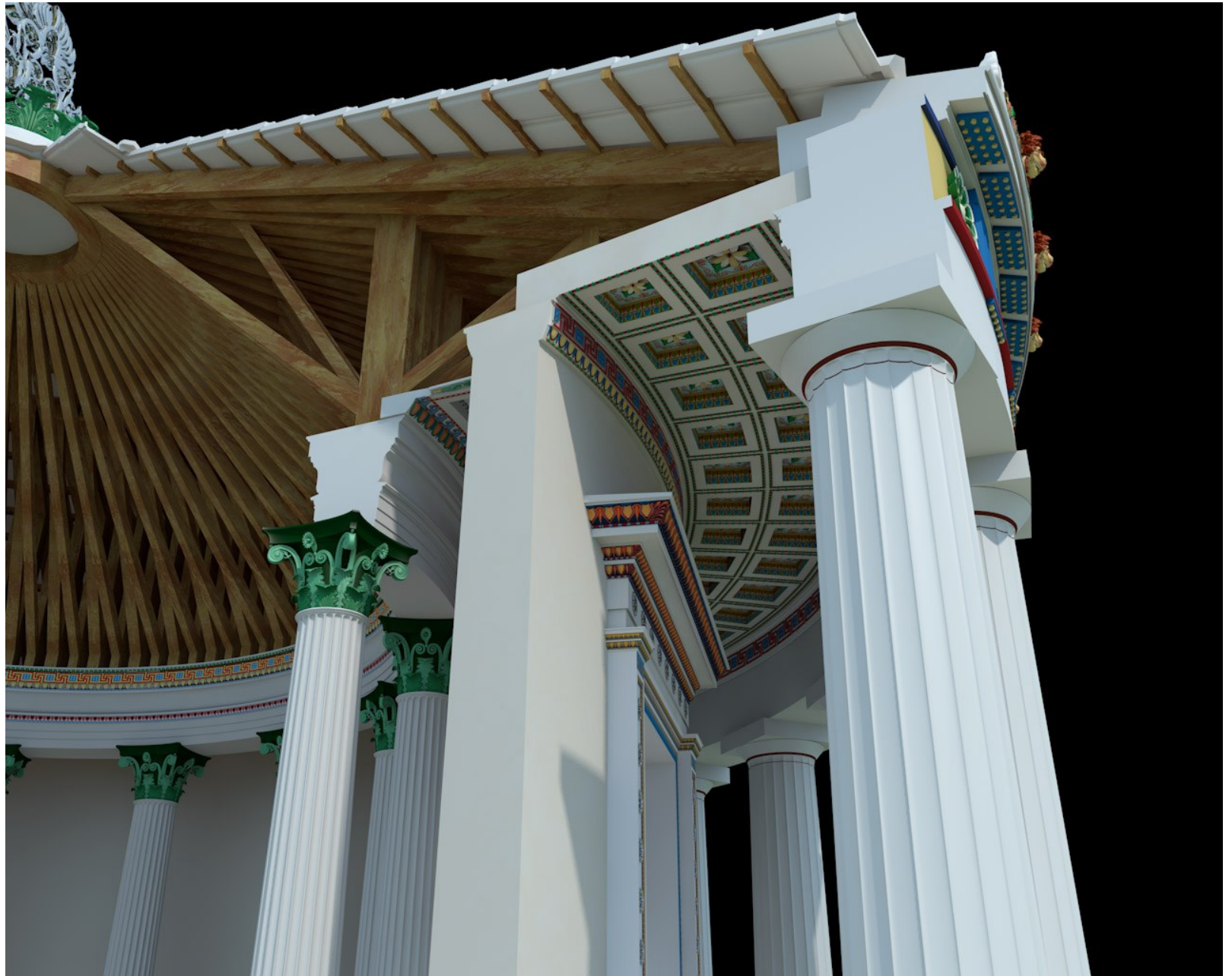

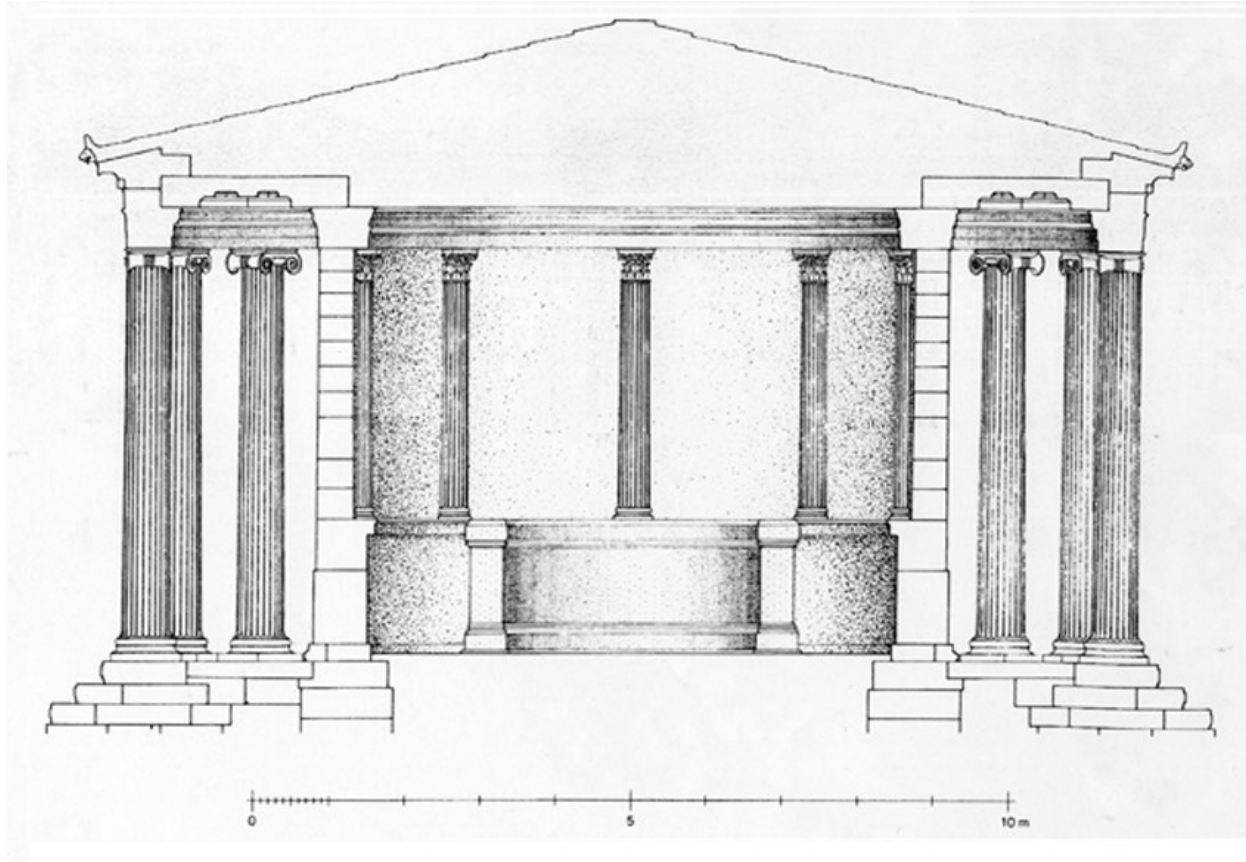

Ionic tholos with Corinthian columns in the interior



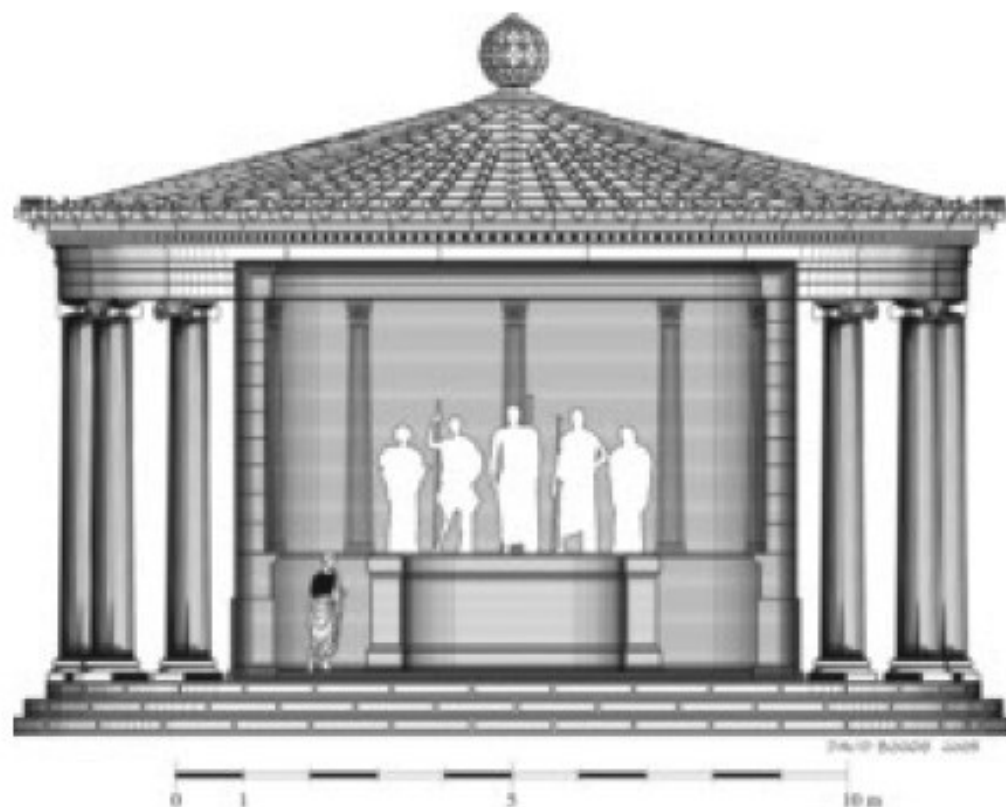
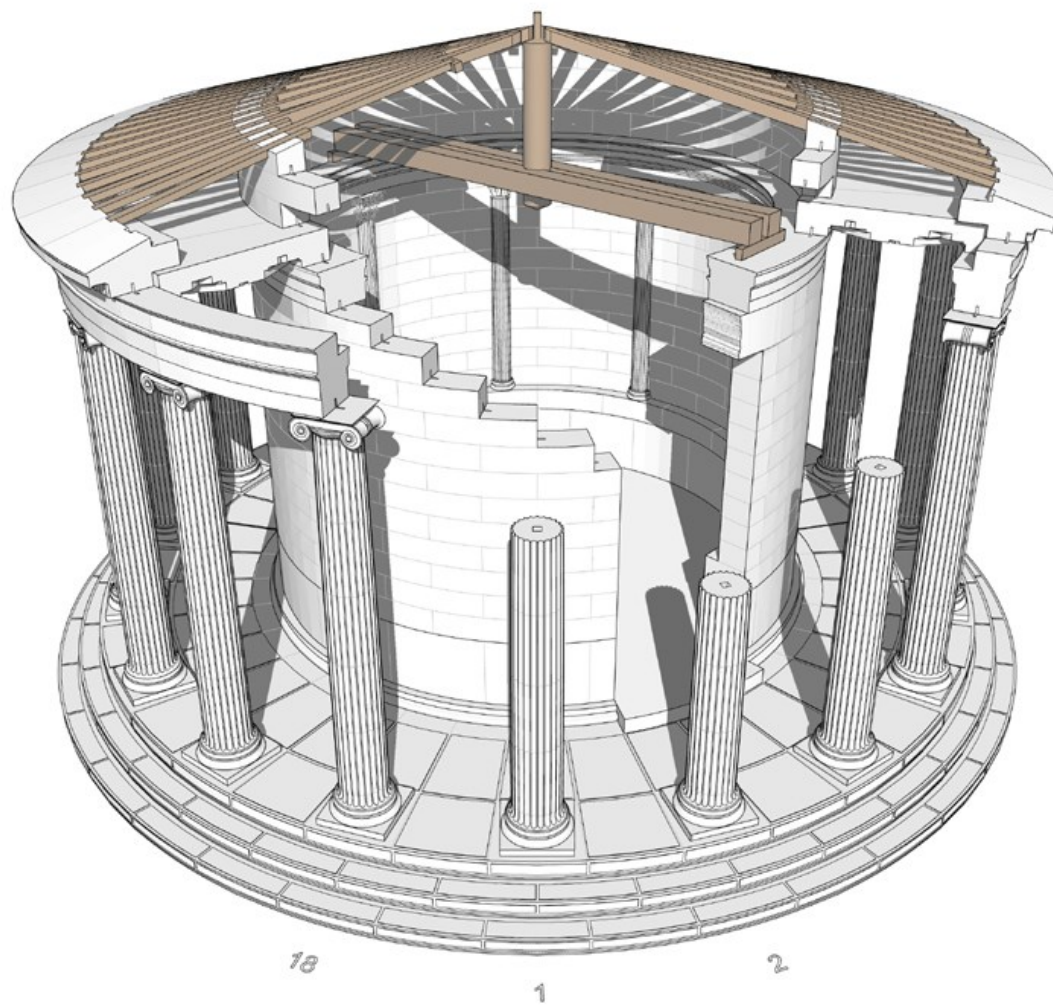


Fig. 6. Cut-away elevation of the Philippeion's interior incorporating some recent discoveries by Klaus Herrmann, Hajo van de Löcht and the author. (Drawing by David Boggs after Schlieff 1944)
