Library of the School of Philosophy

General information

In 2001, the Rector's Council decided the foundation of the Library of the School of Philosophy. It was comprised of 16 separate small libraries attached to the various Departments of the School. In October 2018, the 16 libraries were moved to a new building (7.500 sq.m) next to the School, on the University campus, Zografou and in January 2019 the Library of the School of Philosophy opened to the public.

- Every registered library member of the University can borrow books with her academic id card from the Library of the School of Philosophy.

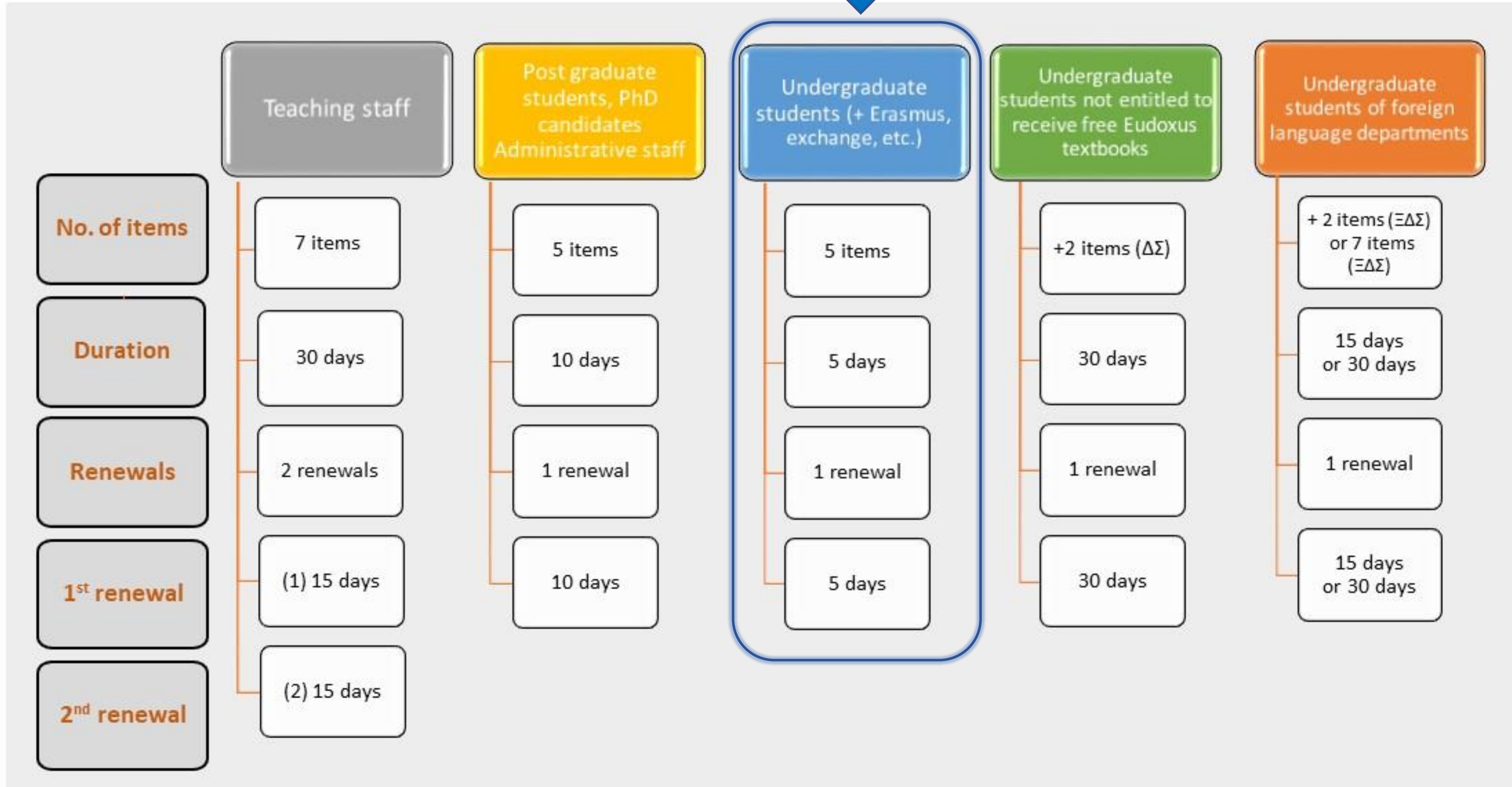
- All checked out items from university library branches are summed up and the time period is calculated in terms of calendar days.

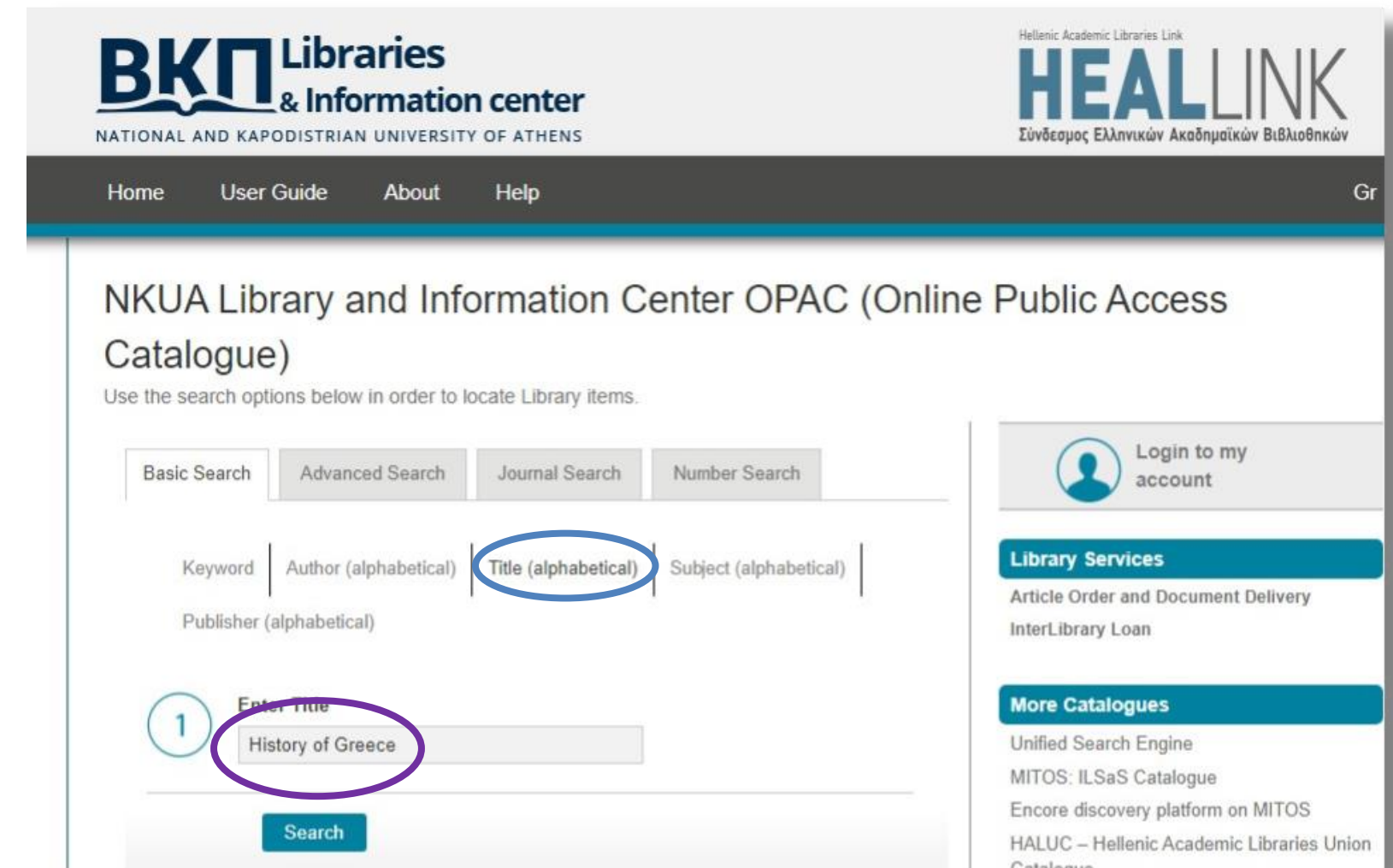
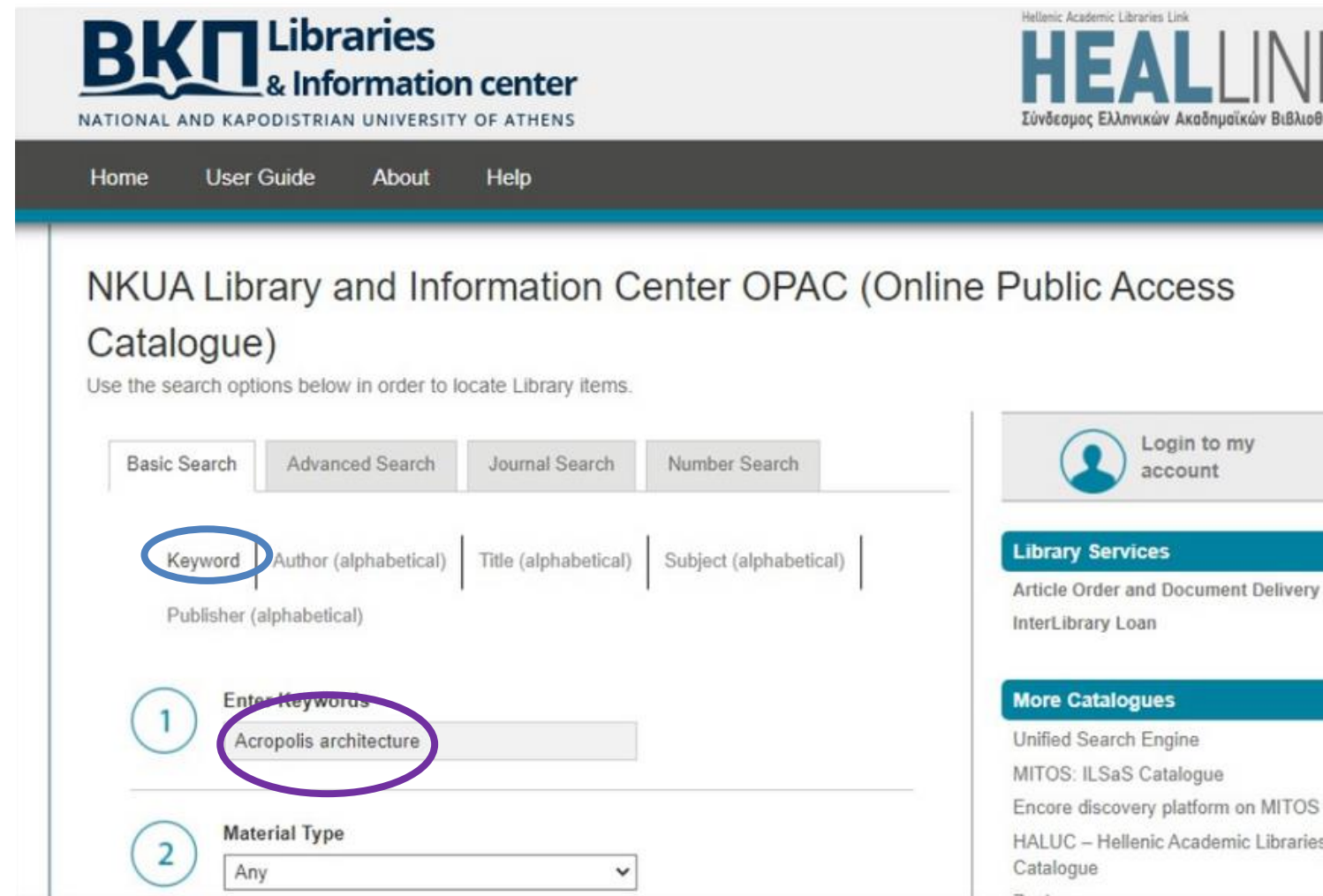

Remote access to NKUA's network

- Via **Virtual Private Network (VPN)**
- Via **Proxy Server**, without installing any other additional software
- Via institutional account - **Shibboleth**, for access to specific publishers though direct contracts with NKUA and HEAL-Link
