## SPSS Installation instructions

Go to the page <a href="http://www.cc.uoa.gr/texniki-ypostiri3h/egkatastash-paketwn-logismikoy/spss.html">http://www.cc.uoa.gr/texniki-ypostiri3h/egkatastash-paketwn-logismikoy/spss.html</a> where the SPSS downloading link is located

- 1. Select the appropriate version, either Windows v.29 or MacOS v.29, for your operating system
- 2. Once you select the appropriate file, the installation file will be downloaded to your computer
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions during installation
- 4. At the end of the software installation the license authorization wizard follows (license authorization wizard)
- 5. There you select the 2nd option "Concurrent User License"
- 6. Fill in the License Manager server name field: spss.uoa.gr
- 7. Finish

It is required before you start running the software if you are off-campus to ensure that you are connected to the university network via the OpenVPN (OpenVPN) service:


After you have completed the installation:

1. You double click the icon that is on your screen



- 2. At the bottom right of the desktop, where the time display is located, a new icon will appear

- 4. In the new window that pops up, fill in the username and password fields with the account details you have in the Network Operations and Management Center.



5. After the connection has been established, the OpenVPN icon will turn green.
