



# Who believes in astrology?

Belief that astrology is not scientific by age






Percentage of people that consider that astrology is not scientific by age

The main theory: the Barnum Effect




Bertram Forer, researches about the Barnum Effect in 1949

Bauer and Durant, 2015: astrology is attractive to people with intermediate levels of scientific knowledge

The metaphysical unrest hypothesis

Bauer and Durant, 2015: astrology is attractive to people with strong religious belief and intermediate religious integration

The F-scale: «F» stands for fascist

The favorableness of Negative signs: Taurus, anger, Virgo, Scorpio, Capricorn, Pisces The belief in astrology depends on the favorableness and the social desirability of the sign

The feeling of belonging


We can change our belief to avoir the black sheep effect or to be part of a group.
