 Euroscepticism 'expresses the idea of contingent or qualified opposition, as well as incorporating outright and unqualified opposition to the process of European integration' (Paul Taggart, 'A touchstone of dissent', EJPR 1998)

(Disagree with nature of EU as political system: demand for national sovereignty & Europe of Nation-states)



POLICY SCEPTICISM

(Disagree with EU policy direction)
