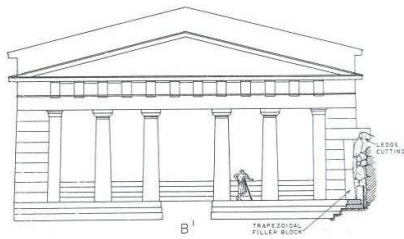




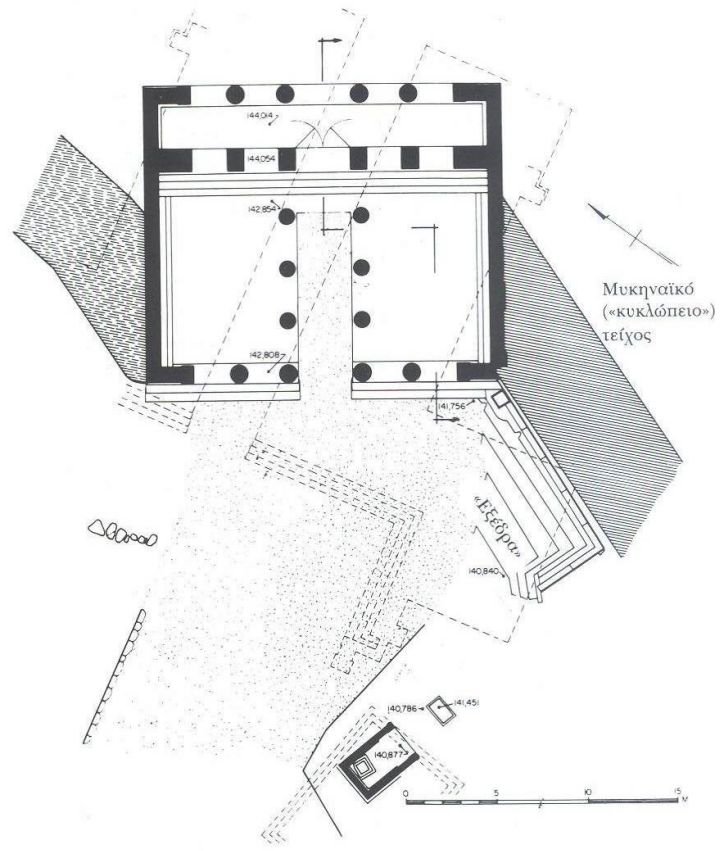


200 Mycenaean gateway restored, shown in broken lines in relation to the Propylaea and the shrine of Athena Nike.

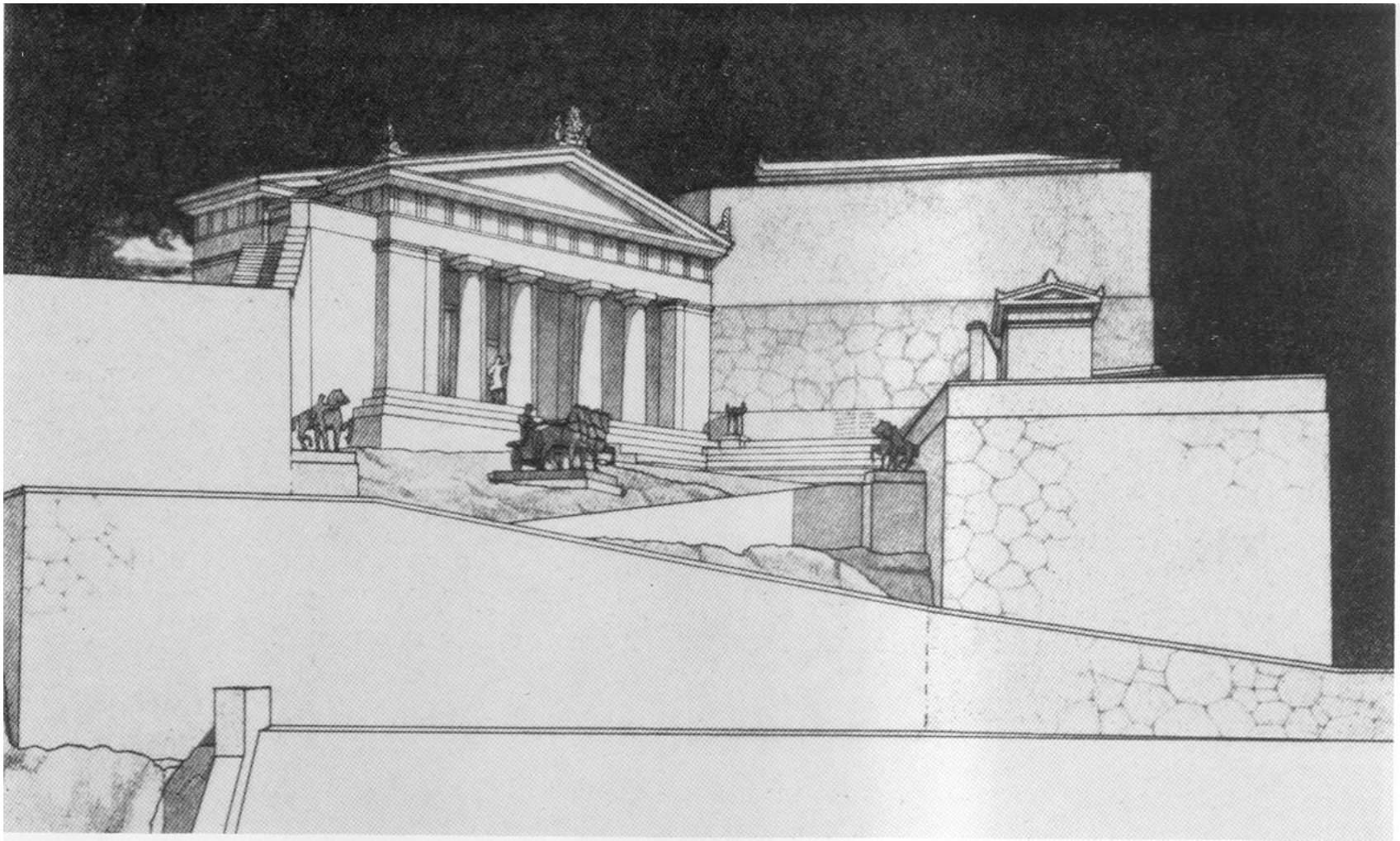
A. Base, fig. 201 - B. Inscribed altar - C. Base - D. Poros naiskos - E. Altar - F. Corner of Old Propylon

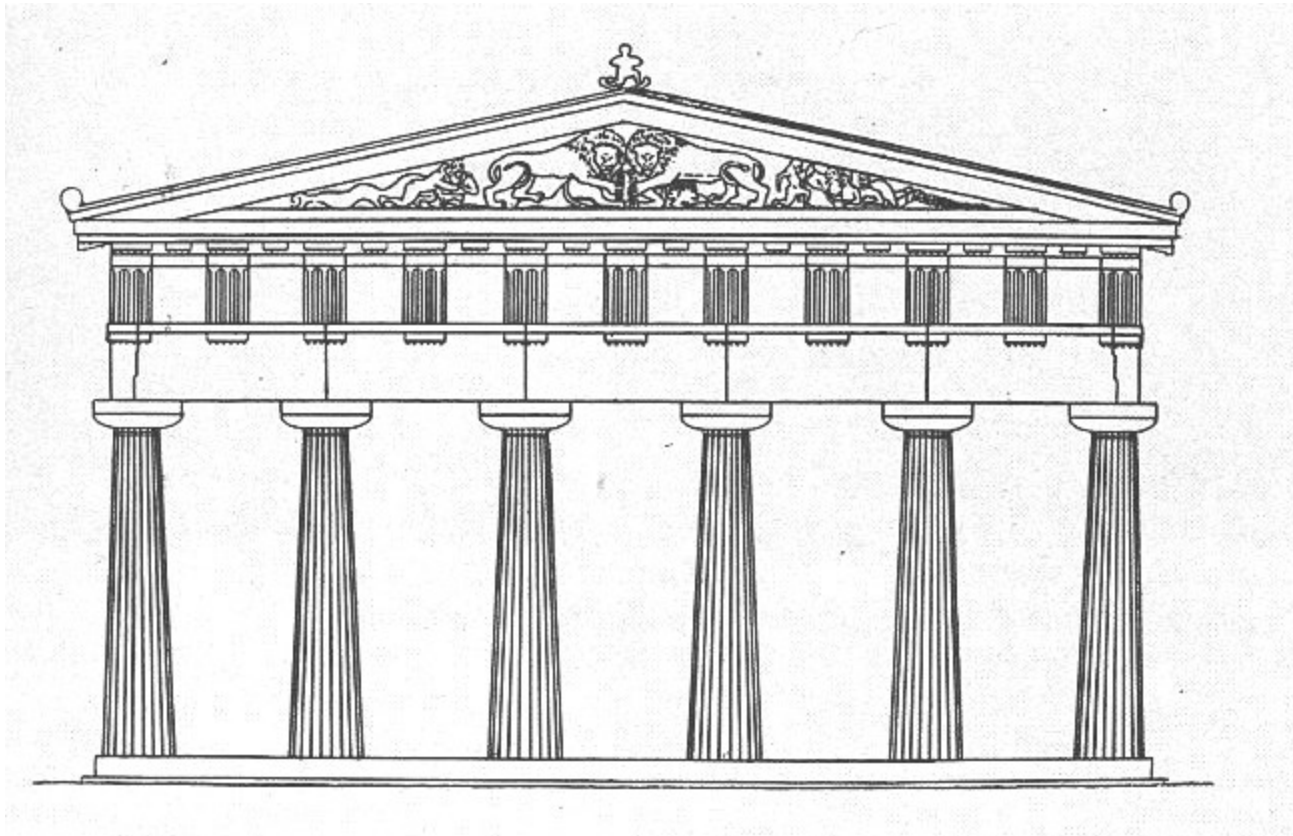


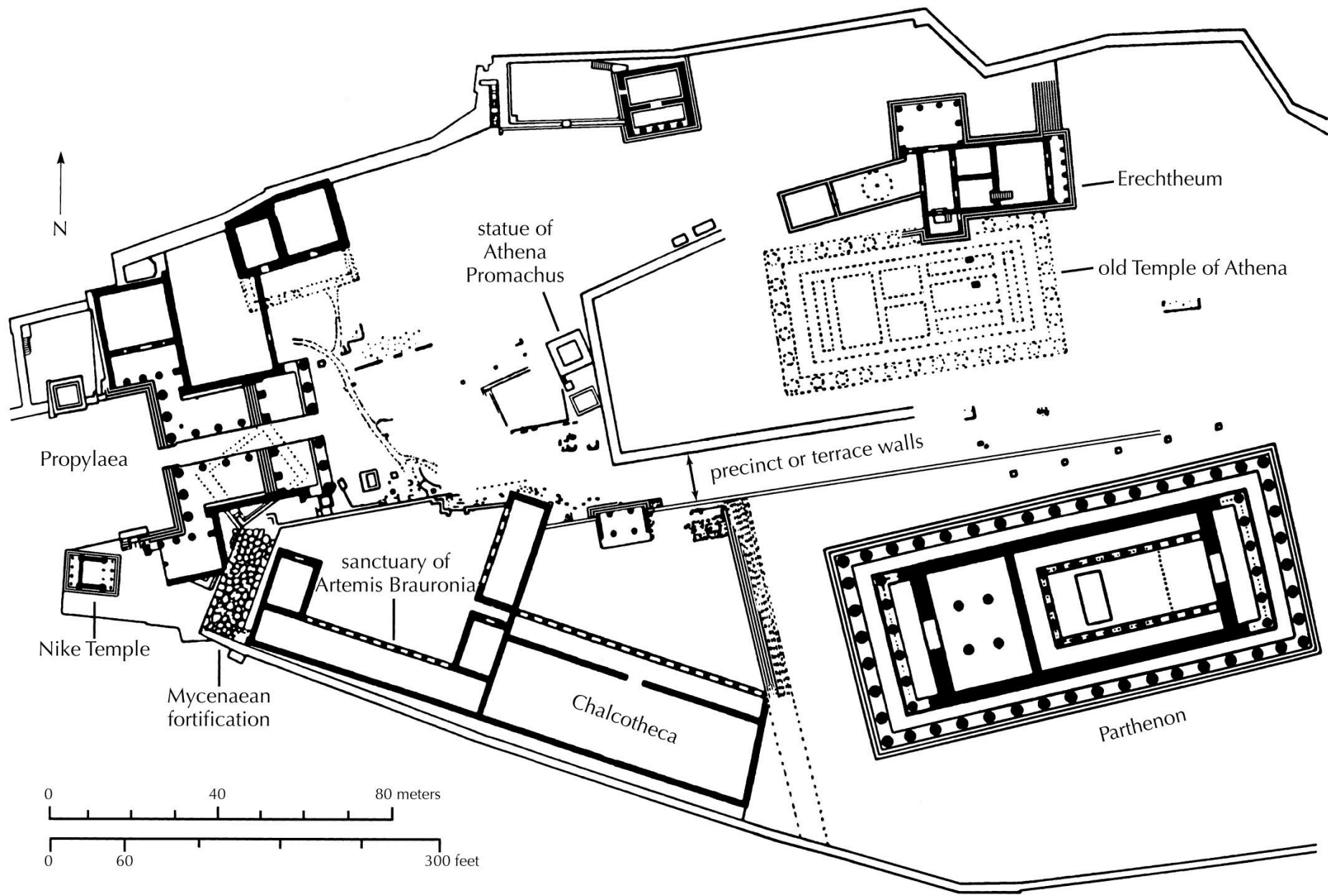
Plan of the Erechtheion, Acropolis, Athens, Greece

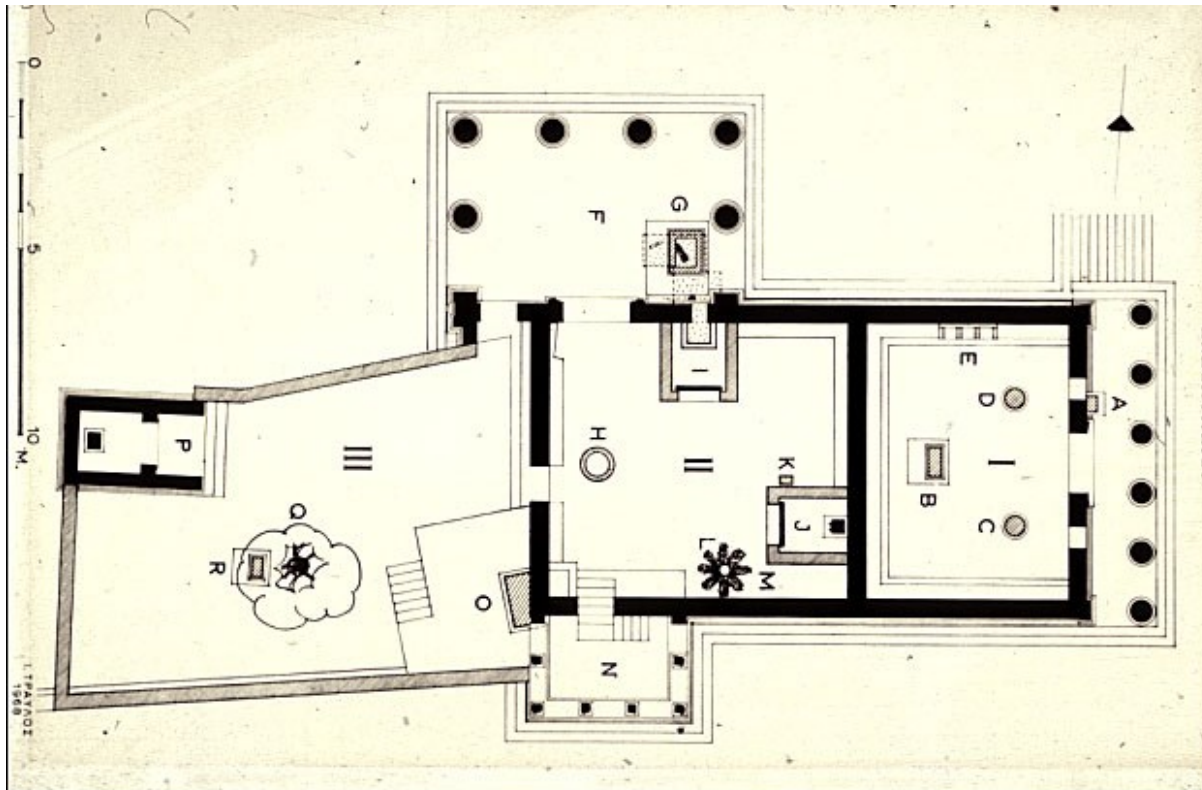

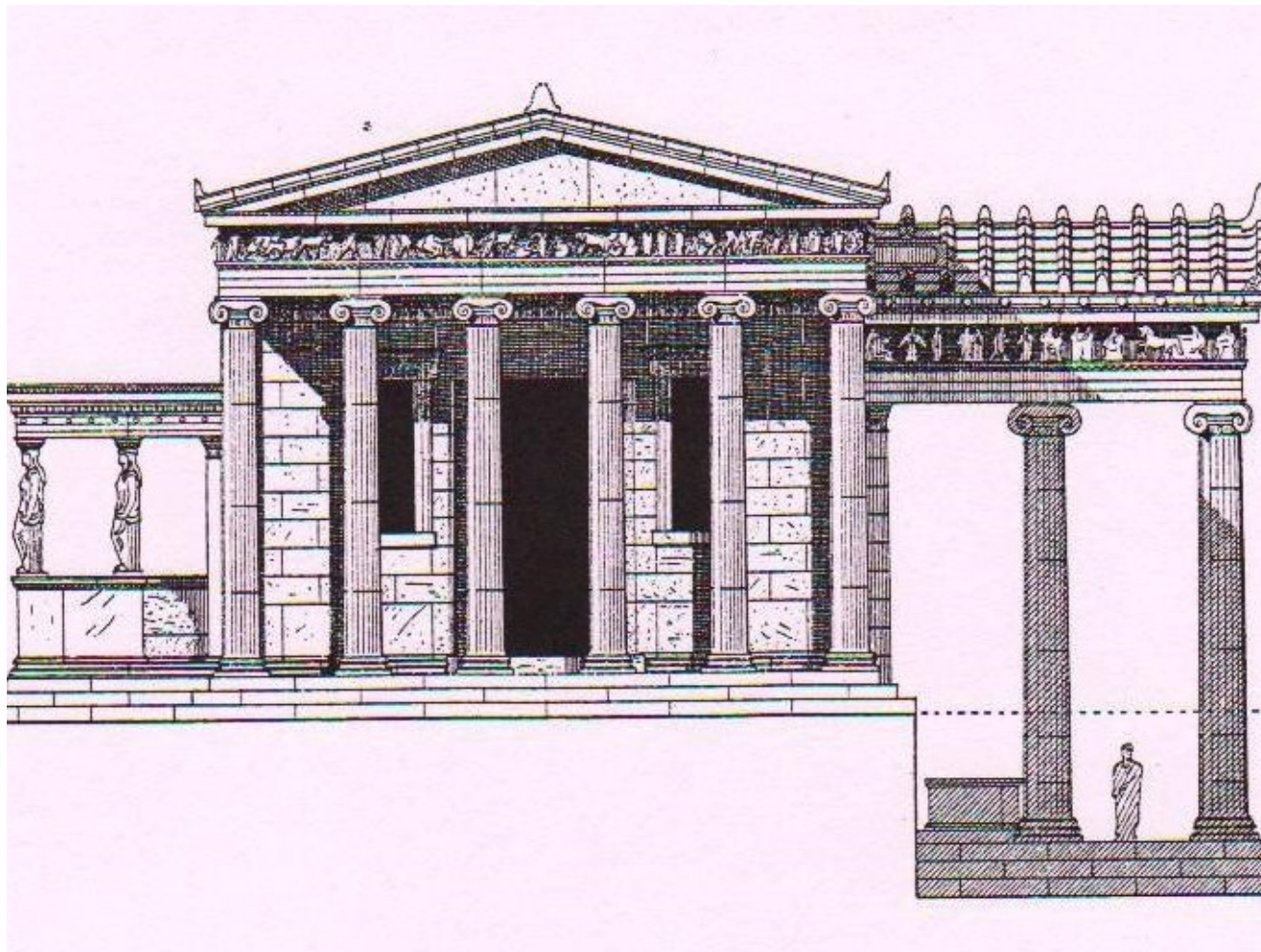


389) Plan by John Travlos with location of various cults, artifacts, etc., Erechtheion, north side of Akropolis, 421-415 & 409-406 B.C.

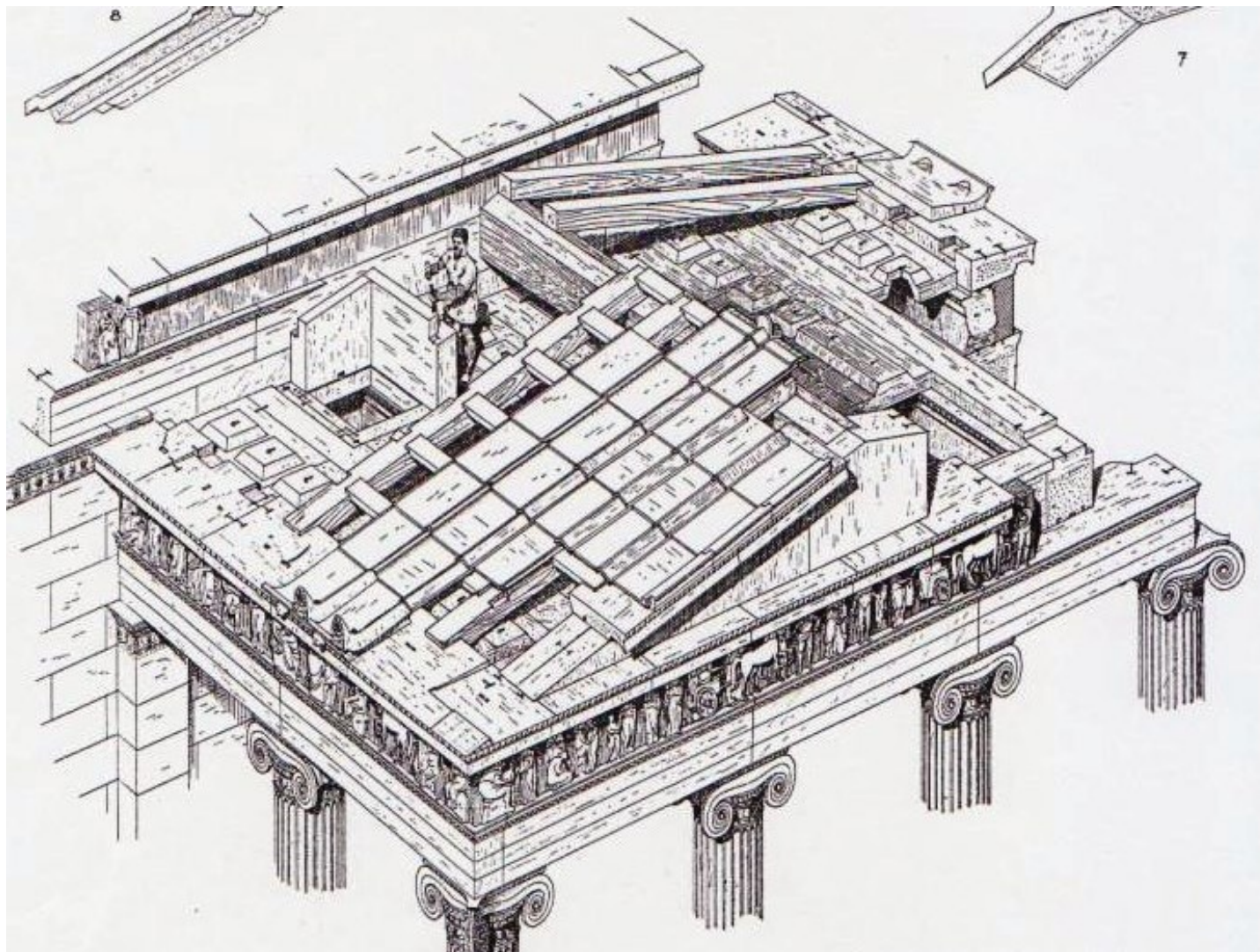
