In addition, and not to be overlooked, the field of physical education itself is producing a considerable amount of important research that has definite value for the developmental and adapted program. To ----- this knowledge and to apply it is a tremendous but challenging task; minimum effectiveness depends upon it.

All areas of human endeavor which have reached a mature perspective and have achieved universal prestige have done so through logical thought processes. Such recognition should be an ultimate ----- of physical education. When a fair share of professional activity is based upon known facts or upon well-conceived hypotheses in the absence of ----- evidence developmental and adapted physical education will become worthy of ultimate recognition in education and in society. Sensitivity to current research provides a ----- to practices for many professions, such as medicine, physiology, psychology, sociology, and economics. A similar sensitivity should -----, the physical educator engaged in this specialty.
