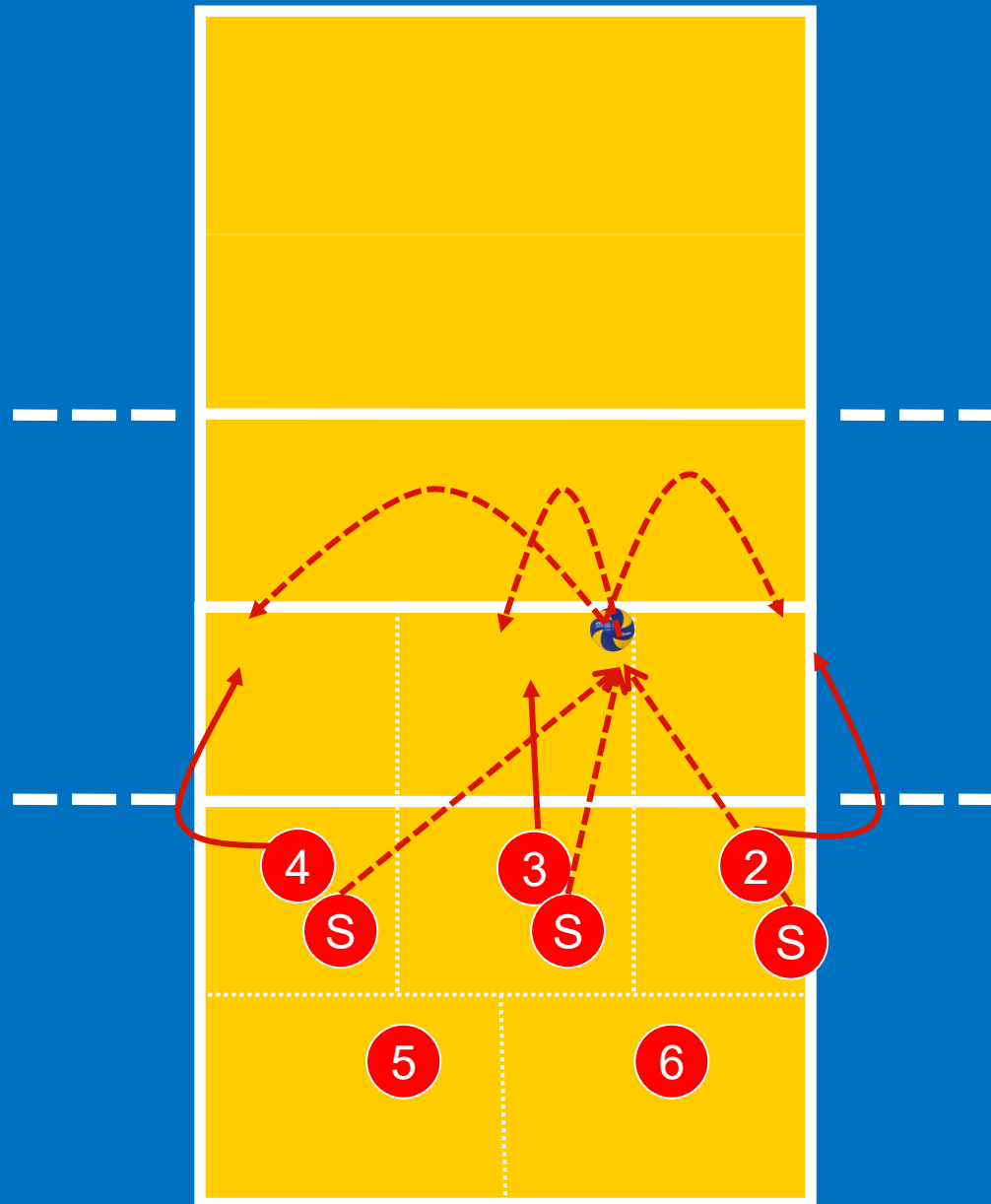


- Add positions of attack

- All players equal participation
- Holistic approach to play
- Players' absences do not affect the training plan.

- Differentiated attack tempo
- Difficulties in the training time distribution
- Organization of training plan
- Further specialization of the players

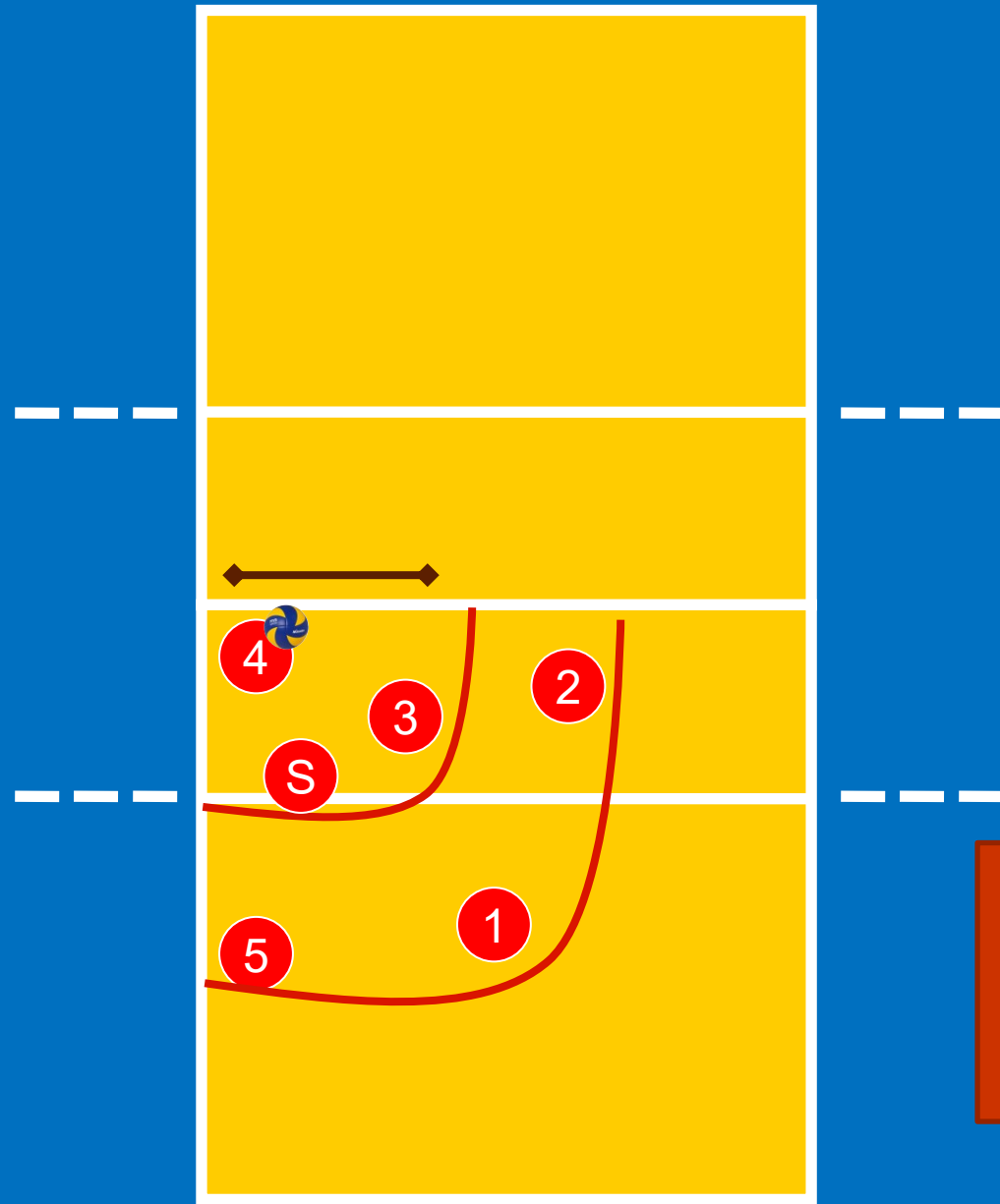

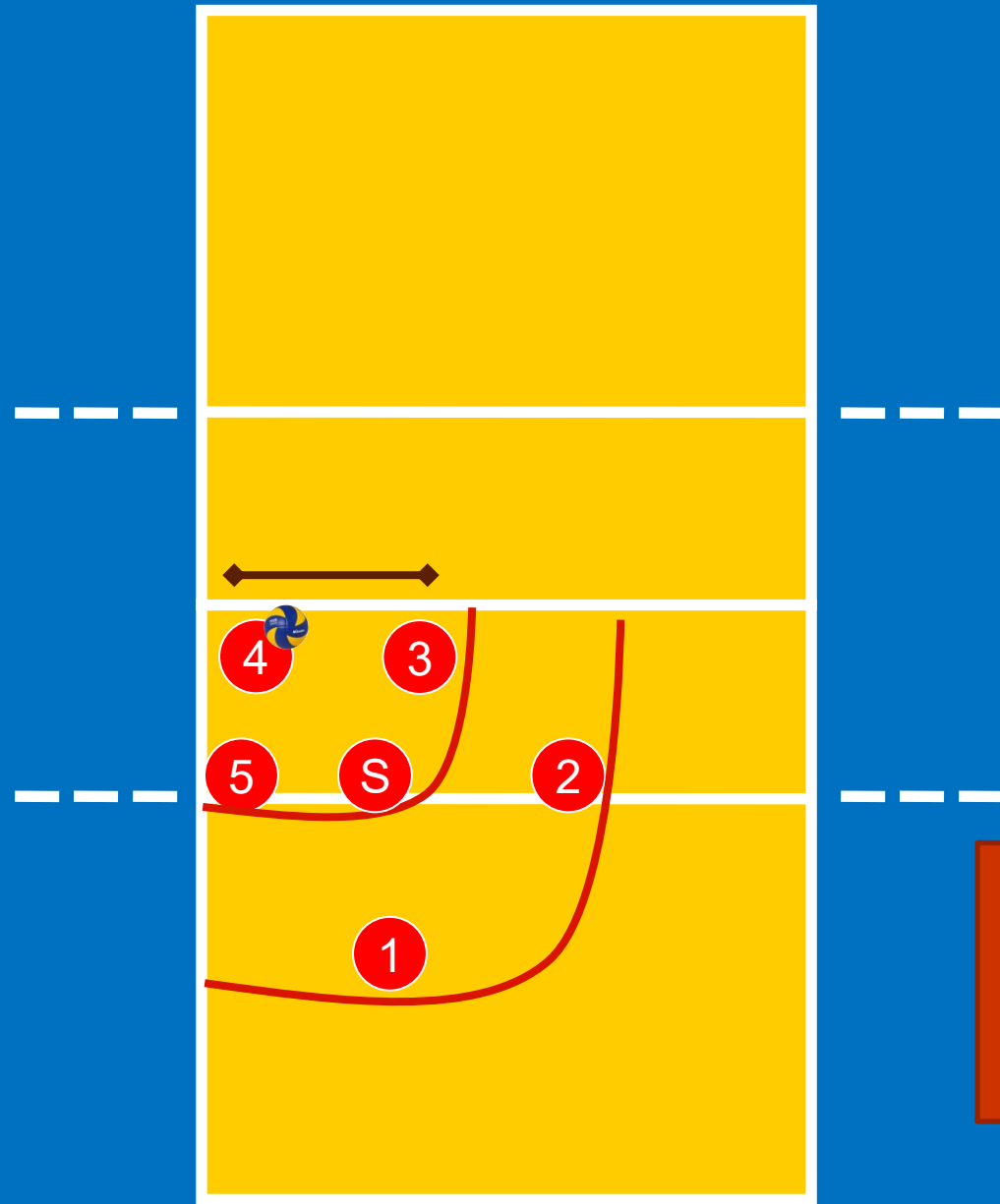

Offense system 6:2



- More attack options
- More capable attackers
- Alternative setter in the court
- Holistic approach of the game
 - Easy for training plan

- At least 2 multitasker players
- Different attack tempo for each setter
- Hard to allocate training time
- Roster of the team
- Offensive system for the 2nd team
- Further Specialization of the players

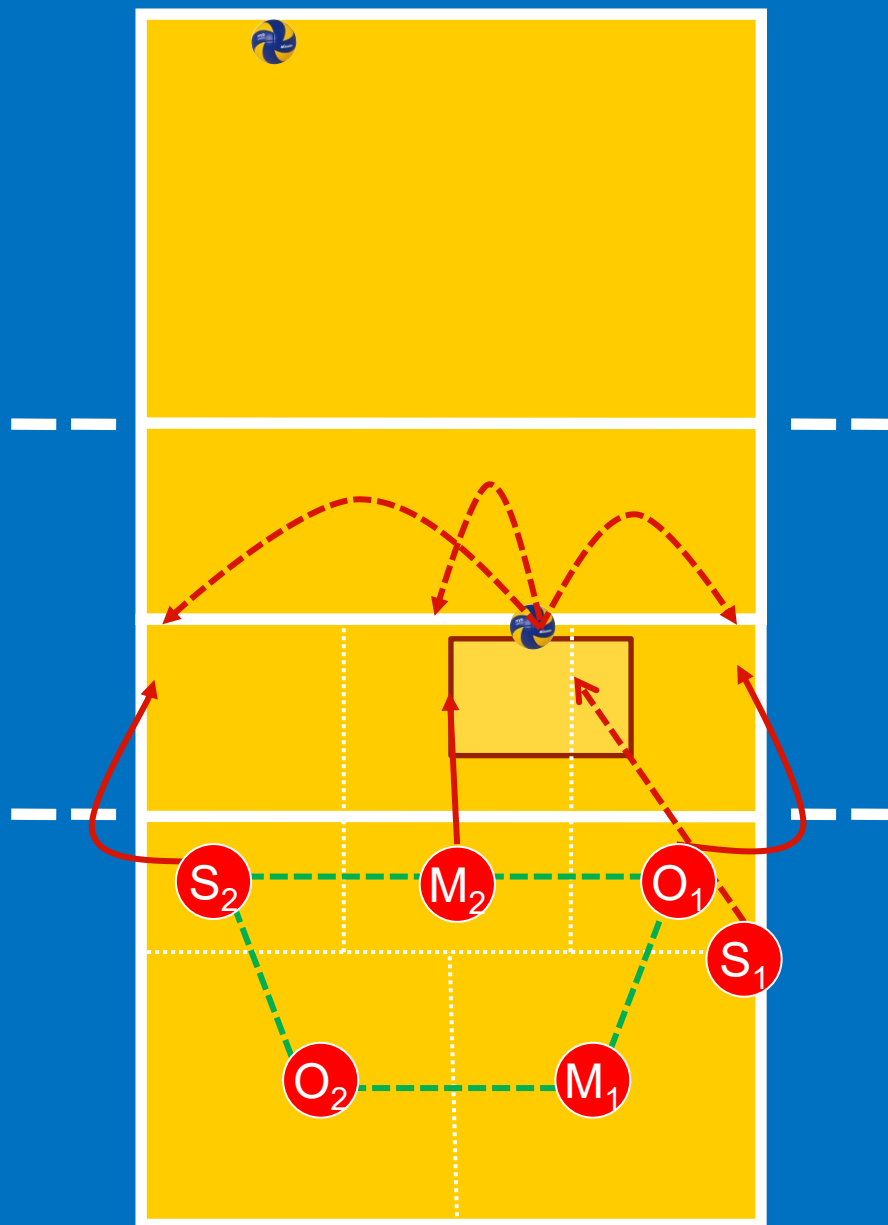
